Biographical Information

Mark Boulware (d. 1811) was a prominent citizen of Caroline County, Virginia. He had 5 children by his first wife Milly, including Frances (1780-1870) and 7 by his second wife Agnes (d. 1836), including Elliott (1795-1861) and Ophelia (b. 1801). Ophelia married James Heywood Broaddus (ca. 1796-1872).

Scope and Content

Papers, 1790-1866, of the Boulware family of Caroline County, Virginia, consisting of deeds, 1790-1866, for property in Caroline County to and from members of the Boulware family and others; and wills, 1829, of Elliott Boulware and Agnes Boulware, both of Caroline County.

Deed, dated 8 January 1866 and recorded 12 March 1866, for 197 7/8 acres in Caroline County from James H. Broaddus and Mildred Ann Broaddus to Virginia Broaddus.

Will, dated 27 July 1829, of Elliott Boulware of Caroline County.

Will, dated 25 December 1829, of Agatha Boulware of Caroline County.
