Included are a floor plan, specifications, and an order for an addition to the courthouse (1805); specifications and a bond for construction of a jail (1807), and floor plan, elevations, and detail drawings, a report, specifications, and an order for the construction of a jail building (1842).

Of particular note are the drawings for the 1842 jail structure. These watercolor elevations and detail drawings are well-executed and signed by David Bissett.
