## Historical Information

Chesterfield County was named for Philip Dormer Stanhope, fourth earl of Chesterfield, British statesman and diplomat, and was formed from Henrico County in 1749.

## Scope and Content

Walker and William B. Woodbridge on the second part 1865 Dec. 21; between Philip Johnson and Lawson Nunnally 1860 Mar. 6; between James Brown and Robert Temple, 1832; between David H. Reed and John B. Crenshaw on the first part and Nathaniel P. Crenshaw on the second part 1848 June 29; between the Trustees of the town of Manchester and R.D. Hogan 1868 Feb. 17; between R.D. Hogan and William Wallace, 1871 July 11; and between George Evans and William R. Johnson and George Markham, 1806.
