Historical Information

James City County was named for James I. It was one of the eight shires established in 1634. Parts of New Kent and York Counties were added later. Its area is 144.1 square miles, and the county seat is in the city of Williamsburg.

All county court records were destroyed by fire in Richmond on 3 April 1865.

Scope and Content

James City County (Va.) Bonds/Comissions/Oaths, 1870-1908 circa, typically consist of bonds, commissions, oaths, certificates, and appointments related to holding public office. Some collections can include ministers' bonds.
