Historical Information

Context for Record Type: Business Records, both volumes and loose records, are in some cases transferred to the Library of Virginia as components of court record transfers. These business records in some cases were simply stored in the local court building for safe keeping by business owners. In other cases, business records (particularly ledgers, account books, etc.) may have been filed in a court case as an exhibit. These business record exhibits appeared both in chancery causes and in judgments, these records serving as exhibits for business dissolution cases, debt suits, and contract disputes.

Locality History: Nelson County was formed in 1807 from Amherst County. The county was named for Thomas Nelson, Jr., governor of Virginia from June to November 1781. The county seat is Lovingston.

Scope and Content

Nelson County (Va.) Business Records, 1921-1924, is currently comprised of a contract book created by the Tobacco Growers Cooperative Association.

Scope and Content

Historical Information: The Tobacco Growers Cooperative Association conducted business in Nelson County during the early 20th century.

Scope and Content: The contract book, 1921-1924, from the local Tobacco Growers Cooperative Association in Nelson County. It recorded the marketing agreement made between the cooperative and its members in Nelson County and contracts signed by the individual members acknowledging the agreement. Information contained in the contracts include the name and address of the member; the date

the contract was signed; amount of tobacco produced in a given year; number of acres planted; and the type of tobacco grown (dark or bright).
