Inside on the bottom right-hand corner of the liner was what appears to be the receiving side of a hook. It was safety pinned in, perhaps upside-down. The number "133" is upside-down on a grayish-brown flattened cord, the "1" is navy blue, the "3's" are pink. The condition is good, a few small holes and stains on the lining.
