Plat 1: Lots C-1, C-2 and C-3, a division of Parcel "C", "Georgetown", and C-4, a portion of the land of the University of Virginia, C-3 to be added to the land of the Univ. of Va. and C-4 to be added to C-2; Charlottesville, Dec. 1963.

Plat 2: Physical survey of lot located at N.W. corner 5th St. S.W. and Dice St. shown as Parcel 63 on tax map 29; Charlottesville, Oct. 1965.

Plat 3: Plat showing a survey of J.W. Bagby property; Charlottesville, December 1964.

Plat 4: Plat of the McAllister property on Ware Street in Charlottesville, Virginia show on city tax map 28 as Parcels 251 and 252; March 24, 1964.

Plat 5: Plat showing street line to be established on Rugby Rd. and Gentry La. along property of Paul Saunier Jr. and Jane M. Saunier; Charlottesville, Sept. 29, 1966. [copy faded]
