Mont Hubbard, Jr. was born in 1910 in Chatham, Virginia. He graduated from VMI in 1932 and went on to become a businessman. From 1940 to 1946 he was a Colonel with the United States Army. Hubbard died in 1968 in Altavista, Virginia.
