Harvey J. Stokes is a Professor of Music at Hampton University, where he is the founder and director of the Computer Music Laboratory. He received his PhD in Music Composition from Michigan State University, a Masters of Music from the University of Georgia, and a Bachelors of Music from East Carolina University.

Dr. Stokes is the author of two books, *Compositional Language in the Oratorio The Second Act: the Composer as Analyst* and *A Selected Annotated Bibliography on Italian Serial Compositions*.

Several of his pieces have been featured on Oxford String Quartet recordings.
