The records contain minutes, committee reports, president and treasurer reports, state and national club reports, yearbooks, handbooks, programs, state Board of Governors' meetings reports, a register, and material from the files of the club. Of interest are papers concerning a suit joined against the University of Virginia over "Morea, " a Charlottesville estate. In addition there are miscellaneous letters from Club members as well as histories of the Club written by Elizabeth B. Gamble and Mary Stuart Cocke Goodwin. The former contains many amusing anecdotes documenting the social life and customs of the members who were also among the socially and economically elite of Albemarle County. These earlier additions are described in the VIRGO catalog.
