This addition to the Joseph M. Brucoli Great Collection consists of five items, 1918, [1995?], and undated, including three sepia photographs of United States Army enlisted men, a cloth sample card produced by the Great War Militaria Company for World War I reproduction uniforms manufactured by the firm, and a "Third Liberty Loan" button. The photographs of an unidentified soldier with two women, Sergeant Major Metalle Gemmill after emerging from the trenches at the Verdun front, and Thomas Benton Northoull (1897-?) who died from wounds received in action on August 6 and was buried at [Cantrexville, Vaseges].
