Scope and Contents

Accounts, bills, and receipts for such items as staves, foodstuffs, fabrics, clothing, [doctor's?] visits, and wheat of Richard G. Dunn, Prince George Co., Va. 18 items.

Business correspondence of Richard G. Dunn, City Point, Prince George Co., Va., including a Prince George Co. court order, Jan. 1868, concerning the building of a bridge across Powell's creek. 3 items.

Business correspondence, account, and bill of Mrs. Sarah A. Dunn, Richmond, Va.; includes bill, 1 July 1878,

from a wholesale and retail ice dealer, with a detailed letterhead showing a drawing of an ice wagon drawn by horses, and a man delivering ice; also includes two receipts, 1842, for plum cake with icing from E[?] R[?]; items regarding the boarding of the Misses Eppes; and a letter, 1881, written to Mrs. S. A. Dunn as Ex[ecu]t[ri]x of the estate of R. G. dunn. 6 items.

Accounts, bills, receipts, and business correspondence relating to Capt. Daniel Eppes, Petersburg, Va., and later to his estate, Richard G. Dunn, executor; includes receipt, October 1836, to Thomas Andrews for making a pine coffin, and other receipts for the schooling of Eppes children, and doctors' visits. 38 items.

Accounts, bills, and receipts of Richard G. Dunn as related to his position of assignee of J. E. Hubbard; includes a receipt, 17 December 1852, of R. G. Dunn serving as executor of the estate of Lucretia Thweatt. 5 items.

Bills, accounts, including ones for medical visits, receipts, and other business correspondence of the estate of Lucretia Thweatt, Prince George Co., Va., Richard G. Dunn, executor, with the name Mary T. Hubbard appearing frequently. 20 items.
