She visits Tokyo, Kyoto, Hong King, Canton, Shanghai, Suzhou, Xian and Beijing. She visits every important site during all her stops, which includes palaces, museums, Tokyo navy yard, restaurants, temples, embassies, gardens, parks, theatres, factories, schools, rivers, lakes, markets, terra cotta statues, hot springs and more. She describes in great detail what she sees and experiences, including restaurants, ceremonies, shopping areas, hotels, culture, the people, art, weather, roads, food, and transportation.
