Biographical Information:

Hunter Booker Andrews was a Virginia State Senator from Hampton, Virginia. He graduated from Elizabeth City High School in 1938 and was a student at the College of William and Mary from 1938-1942. After college, Andrews joined the United States Navy during World War II.

Scope and Contents

This collection contains photographs, speeches, clippings, and other material concerning Hunter B. Andrews, a Virginia Senator and alumnus of the College of William and Mary. The bulk of the papers document Andrews' time as a Virginia State Senator from the 1980s to the 1990s and cover such topics as business development, education in Virginia, and speeches given at various occasions throughout Virginia. Also included are papers from Andrews' time in the United States Navy during World War II, family photographs, and material from Andrews' high school and college days. The collection contains only a small amount of material related to Andrews' tenure on the Board of Visitors of the College and William and Mary from 2003-2005.
