Scope and Contents

For the sum of five shillings, George Muse grants Battaile Muse two tracts of land along the Kanhawa River in Botetourt County; one tract is 2000 acres and one tract is 100 acres; the 2000 acre tract is part of a tract of 6000 acres owned by William Bronaugh and leased and released to George Muse 20 and 21 October 1776; the two tracts of land will be adjoining; the 100 acres are part of a 7894 acre tract, divided by deed of p[ar]tition from James Craik on 21 October 1776; the 100 acres begin from the old 7894 acre tract and run along the river until it meets the 2000 acre tract; Battaile Muse receives all rights and privileges to the land; from present for one year paying rent of "one pepper corn" on 25 March 1777 (Lady Day) as indenture; signed by Geo[rge] Muse and witnessed by Edm[un]d Pendleton, Jr., James Taylor, Jr., and James Upshaw.
