Thomas Lawrence Long is a Professor of English and a noted writer in the areas of religious studies, gender and sexuality, and health. He earned an M.A. in English from the University of Illinois, Urbana in 1977 and an M.A. in Theology from the Catholic University of America in 1981. From 1980-1988, Long served as a Pastor in the Catholic Diocese of Richmond. In 1997, he completed his PhD in English at Indiana University of Pennsylvania. Dr. Long taught English at Thomas Nelson Community College from 1989-2008. In 1999-2000, he was a Visiting Lecturer at the College of William and Mary. Dr. Long also served as Editor-in-Chief of the Harrington Gay Men's Fiction Quarterly (later changed to Harrington Gay Men's Literary Quarterly) from 2000-2008. In 2008, Dr. Long accepted a position at the University of Connecticut as Associate Professor-in-Residence at the School of Nursing and affiliate in English and in Women's, Gender, and Sexuality Studies, where he remains as of 2014.
