Biographical Information

Augustus Repass, son of Frederick Repass and Rachel Harkrader Repass, was born on 1 October 1814. He married Catherine Tarter on 4 March 1845 and lived in Wythe County, Virginia. He was a farmer; he and his wife had several children including Hiram Repass, Elizabeth Repass, Rhoda Repass, Elbert J. Repass, Caroline Repass, John Repass, and Laura Repass.

Scope and Content

The collection consists of an 1884 Wythe County tax ticket issued to Augustus Repass of the Wytheville District for \$3.87 in personal property tax, state tax, road tax, school tax, and county tax.
