Abstract

Photographic prints and negatives from Wheeling, West Virginia, photographer George J. Kossuth. Collection contains approximately fifty prints and negatives, including color prints and oversize photographs taken by Kossuth between 1904 and 1959, though most of the items are undated. Biographical / Historical

George J. Kossuth was born in Clifton, West Virginia, in 1886, the son of Peter Kossuth, a cabinet-maker and carpenter from Kentucky. In 1909 George Kossuth opened a photography studio in Wheeling, West Virginia. He later served as chairman of the board of the Photographs Association of American and a trustee of the Winona School of Photography. George Kossuth died in 1960.
