## **Biographical / Historical**

Edward C. Tabler (1916-1977) was educated as an engineer at West Virginia University where he received his B.S. degree in 1938 and his M.S. in 1940.

He lived in South Charleston, West Virginia, and held various positions with Union Carbide. In addition to engineering, Tabler also maintained a fascination with the history of South Africa. He dedicated 25 years to researching the topic which resulted in his 1955 book, "The Far Interior: Chronicles of Pioneering in the Matabele and Mashona Countries, 1847-1879."

After over two decades of research, Tabler made his first trip to South Africa in 1957, and he visited many of the locations about which he had written. He also met with several individuals and visited several institutions to further his research. After this initial visit, Tabler returned to southern Africa in 1965, 1967, 1971, and 1973, and he also visited eastern Africa in 1963 and 1969.

The journals of Edward Tabler (10 items) contain detailed accounts of his trips to the regions of southern Africa (1957, 1965, 1967, 1971 and 1973) and eastern Africa (1963 and 1969), to England (1961), and of his voyage on the chemical carrier *S.S. R.E. Wilson* (1960) into the Gulf of Mexico.

Topics discussed in the journals include daily accounts of weather, meals, and events, and other subjects including research, hunting, fishing, and mining.

Locations visited in southern Africa include: Cape Town, Port Elizabeth, Kimberly, Bloemfontein, Free State Goldfields, Johannesburg, Durban, Maritzburg, Pretoria, Lydenburg, Bulawayo, Wankie, Salisbury, Umtali, Stapleford, Inyanga, Gorongosa, Mcllwaine, Vumba, Zimbabwe, Inyati, Strokestown, Matopos, Pandamatenga, Livingstone, Kafue, Lusaka, Luangwa, Chitengo, Kyle Dam Reserve, Bulilima-Mangwe District, Bechuanaland, Ngweshla Pan, Tshabema, Victoria Falls, Kuruman, Upington, Augrabies, Etosha Pan, Swaziland, Transvaal, Mala Mala, Savuti, Khwai, Moremi, Shangani, Beira, Lisbon, Zululand, Kruger, Maun, Xugana, Matusadona, Ghona-re-Zhou, Faro, Hluhluwe, Umfolozi, and Bana Manzi.

Locations visited during Tabler's voyage to England include: Southampton, London, and Cambridge.

Locations visited during Tabler's voyage on the *S.S. R.E. Wilson* include: Carteret, NJ; Texas City, TX; and Galveston, TX.

Special events mentioned throughout the journals include: voyages, trips to southern and central Africa for research and leisure purposes; visits to libraries, museums, and archives, accidents, unfortunate events, sickness, storms, and hunts.
